 EDA's end-to-end grants management system: A one-stop shop for applicants, co-applicants, Tribal Partners, Economic Development Districts (EDDs), and project stakeholders

Key Benefits of EDGE

- Applicants, co-applicants, Tribal Partners, EDDs, and project stakeholders will complete applications and curing through the EDGE Portal
- Provides a modernized, intuitive, and user-friendly interface for applicants
- Increases automation and decreases manual data entry and duplicate data entry
- Visibility into status of grants and action items for both EDA Team Members and applicants

Steps to Apply in EDGE

Step 1: (New User) Register for an EDGE Account at: <u>https://sfgrants.eda.gov</u>

- 1. Select Login
- 2. Select 'I Accept' to accept the System Use Agreement
- 3. Select 'Not a Member?' and follow the prompts

Step 2: Submit grant applications in the EDGE Portal

- 1. Locate the desired Funding Opportunity and select 'Apply Now' and fill-out or upload the details
 - Ensure you select the correct funding path (Readiness, Implementation, or Industry Transformation)
- 2. Submit all required documents (based on funding path selected)
