The EDA University Center at Georgia Southern serves as a one-stop shop for businesses in this region to obtain valuable information and professional support from any of the University's programs focused on economic development and job creation.

The Georgia Southern (GS) EDA University Center supports businesses and entrepreneurs through technical assistance and applied research.

# **Technical Assistance**

The GS EDA University Center provides technical assistance in the form of mentoring, training, business workshops, and networking events.

The center connects entrepreneurs with students to assist with projects such as branding, marketing plans, and public relations strategies. Faculty have also been involved in assisting innovators through the center with chemistry, biology, and engineering issues.

The center also creates workshops and training opportunities for entrepreneurs as well as networking events to strengthen the ecosystem.

# **Applied Research**

The GS EDA University Center conducts research for public and private partnres to aid in the planning process for community and/or business development through market surveys, compensation studies, economic impact reports, and feasibility analyses.

# **Business Innovation Group**

The Business Innovation Group (BIG) combines the professional skills and expertise of the GS EDA University Center with the Center for Business Analytics and Economic Research (CBAER), the Area Small Business Developoment Center (SBDC), the Innovation Incubator, the Fabrication Laboratory (FabLab), SCORE, the Georgia Grown Innovation Center and the Hinesville Innovation Incubator.
